Severe weather Siren (i.e. Tornado):
2 second rise to steady siren.
Loop steady siren every 11 seconds

1. Seek cover in the closest building.
2. Stay away from windows, glass doors, and glass walls.
3. Monitor voicemail, the website or your email for updates.
4. Call 830.278.4401 about damage or injuries.
5. Stay in your area until you receive an all-clear message or hear the outdoor Siren.

1KHZ, steady sound.

Shelter in place Siren: (i.e. Active shooter):
1.5 second rise and decay, repeat.
Loop every 8 seconds

1. Go to the closest room, classroom, or office.
2. Close the door and lock it, if possible.
3. Turn off the lights.
4. Keep everyone as quiet as possible; mute cell phones, computers, etc.
5. Call 911 if you have any information about the intruder or injuries.
6. Stay in your area until you receive an all-clear message or hear the outdoor Siren. **1KHZ,**
